



Grant Background

- U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Utilities Service (RUS) Distance Learning and Telemedicine (DLT) Grant
- Three year grant provides a Polycom videoconferencing unit to the most rural buildings in our two county service area
- High rurality scores as defined by the township population from 2000 census
- High poverty scores from the National School Lunch Program





Why the Grant?

- Videoconference content meets curriculum goals.
- Transportation to the high school causes time and cost barriers.
- In March 2003, 79% of teachers surveyed said they would participate in VC if it was in their building.







RUS PD Requirements



- Two "long courses"
- Building Staff Training
 - DL demo in first 3 months after installation
 - Four teachers participate in other training over the 3 years
- Non-VC PD: 1 per year


